On Thursday morning we are very excited because the children will be having an interactive storytelling workshop about our topic, 'The Great Fire of London'. Please make sure that you have returned the permission slip before then.

Learning this week

English: This week we have been learning more about Samuel Pepys diary. We have identified the features of a diary (first person, emotive language, chronological order etc.). We then planned a diary entry and wrote in from Samuel Pepys perspective. Ask your children to see these during sharing afternoon next week!

Maths: We have been learning about data handling. We have collected data using a tally chart, recorded data using bar graphs and learnt how to interpret the data to answer questions.

Handwriting: We are really focussing on our handwriting and making sure our ascenders/descenders are the appropriate sizes and that our letters are in proportion. Please continue to reinforce the cursive script at home.
