We then learnt about using 'conjunctions' (and, but, so, because, if, when) in our sentences. We have planned our alternative tale and will be writing them next week. In Maths, we have been focusing on number bonds to 10, 20, 100 and even 1000! We have learnt to use our knowledge of bonds to 10 to be able to work out/see the pattern in bonds to other numbers.
