Learning this week

English: This week in English the children have been introduced to the non-chronological report 'The Manchester Ridge Back' which they have internalised by reciting it with pictures and actions to help. We have used this to discuss the features of a non-chronological report and the language used in a report.

Maths: This week the children have been learning about Place Value. They have been using their knowledge of place value to order numbers and compare numbers using the inequality signs.

Topic: During Topic, the children have started to create their seascape collage to show what the sea would have been like when Christopher Columbus was exploring. As the children were creating their seascapes they thought about the different materials they needed to use for the different parts of the collage and thought about how to create different textures in their picture.

Pre-learning

Next week in Topic we are learning about the best materials to use for a ship. It would be beneficial to your child if you could discuss properties of different materials such as stable, waterproof, stiff and check their understanding of floating.

In Maths next week we will be practising counting forwards and backwards in 2, 5 and 10. It would be beneficial for your child if they could practise this at home too.
