Learning this week

English: This week in English we have been learning about instructions. We looked at imperative (bossy) verbs and discussed why they are important when we write instructions. We have planned and written our instructions on how to make a sandwich of their choice.

Maths: This week the children have been learning about doubling and halving. We used partitioning to work out what the double would be. We also linked our knowledge of multiplying by 2 to solve doubles. When learning about halving and we used division to help us. We shared out amounts into two groups to work out what half of a number would be.

Pre-Learning

Maths: Next week we are learning about multiplication and division. To help your child it would be beneficial for them to recap multiplication vocabulary. Such as: multiply, times, groups of and lots of. It would be beneficial to do the same for division. The vocabulary for division is: Sharing, grouping and divide.
