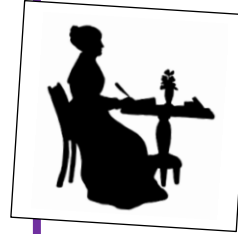
We had Mark the Science Man in again and learned about teeth and their function. We thoroughly enjoyed making teeth moulds and then decorating them.
