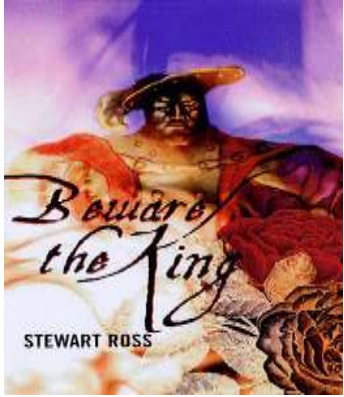


This Week
