Let's celebrate!

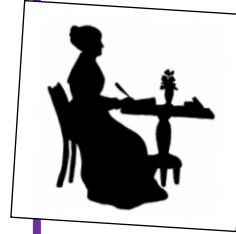
Proud cloud: Sapphira - for excellent effort with her writing this week whilst innovating the Jack and the Beanstalk story.
