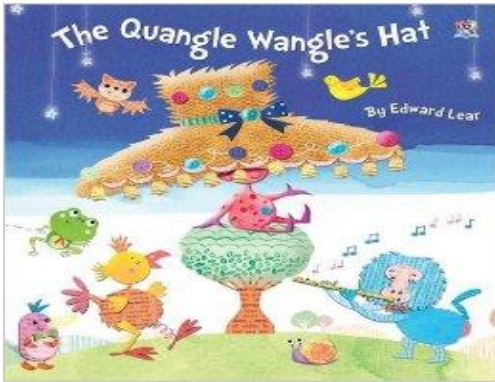


This Week

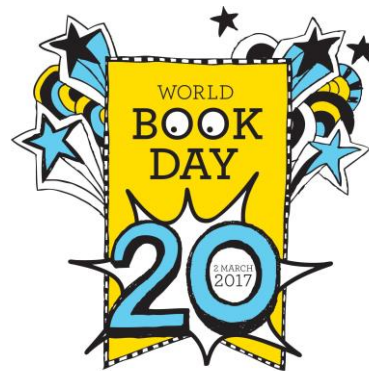
