Learning this week

English: This week in English we have continued to learn about instructions. We made some African Chapati's with Mrs Parker and wrote the instructions for how we made them.

Maths: This week the children have been learning about multiplication and division. We solved word problems for each operation. We used our multiplication facts to solve these questions and when solving the division word problems we used sharing. Then we looked at how we can use our times tables to help solve division questions. We also used our times tables to check our division answers.

Pre-Learning

Maths: Next week during maths sessions we will be practising our times tables by singing songs and playing games. It would be beneficial for your child if they could practise the 2, 5 and 10 times tables at home. We will also be counting forwards and backwards in these steps.
