Learning this week

This week the children started exploring the traditional tale 'Goldilocks and the three bears'. We hot-seated different characters to develop our understanding of them better. We then learnt about using 'conjunctions' (and, but, so, because, if, when) in our sentences. We have planned our alternative tale and will be writing them next week.

In Maths, we have been focusing on number bonds to 10, 20, 100 and even 1000! We have learnt to use our knowledge of bonds to 10 to be able to work out/see the pattern in bonds to other numbers.

During Topic we have begun looking at what happened during the Great Fire of London. We know the fire started on Pudding Lane and that the Mayor of London went back to sleep when he first saw the fire!
