### Learning this week

**English:** This week in English we have been continuing to learn about Explanation texts. We have been searching the internet to find out information about puppets to help us plan our own explanation text. We have begun writing our own text about puppets. We have included casual connectives and generalisers.

**Maths:** This week we have continued learning about subtraction and addition. We have been bar models to help us solve 2 step word problems. We began practically and have worked our way up to drawing visual representations. We can now use bar models as a way of showing our thinking. We have also had another look at column subtraction. It would be good for your child to practice this at home.
