Pre-learning/Remembrance Day

Each week we will be including some pre learning/activities for you to do with your child. This may be via the Home Learning or in the Newsletter. Pre learning is a way of hooking your child in to key words, ideas, stories or activities, which will give them the advantage of already being familiar with the learning so that they learn faster in class. The typical effect of pre learning/ pre viewing is that it can double the rate of pupils progress in learning. Next week the children will be learning about Remembrance Day. If your child has anything they wish to share (objects, research, family memories etc) please bring them in next week. As part of their home learning the children have been set some research to do on this topic too.

Home Learning and Spelling

Learning this week

English: This week we have been learning about poetry. The children have looked at the poet's use of language and used this to create their own poems.

Maths: We have continued learning about multiplication. We have investigated the patterns in the x2, x5 and x10 tables. Children not ready for their tables yet have focused on counting in 2s, 5s and 10s.

Topic: We had a lovely afternoon yesterday creating some beautiful Autumn Artwork. We enjoyed using paint to create Autumn trees! We have also enjoyed making clay poppies with Miss Burdett.



PSHE: We talked about medicines this week. We discussed how and when medicines are good for us and how to be safe around medicines. Mrs Worts was impressed with how inquisitive we were.
