## Maths and English

This week in maths the children have been learning about number and place value, we have learnt about: place value of 4 and 5 digit numbers; addition and subtraction within place value (eg. Adding multiples of 10, 100 and 1000); comparing 4 and 5 digit numbers using < and >; and solving place value problems. Place value is a key aspect to maths which will support children through their maths skills through the year.

This week we finished our Roald Dahl English unit by writing a long piece about imaginary dreams, inspired by the BFG. We then began a poetry unit, we specifically looked at the works of Roger McGough this week. We have discussed what we like and dislike about the poems and have made comparisons across the poems.
