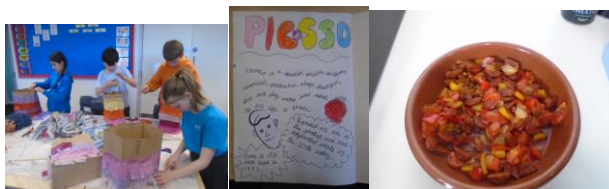


### This week

### Pre learning

This week's pre learning/ pre viewing is: Continuing with measuring angles – we will be working out missing angles on a line, drawing our own angles based on a value of degrees, using directional language (e.g. I am facing north, I turn 90 degrees clockwise, what way am I facing now?)

### Maths and English

This week we started looking at how to measure angles using a protractor and identifying how many degrees in different 2D shapes.

In English, we have been looking at the traditional tale of Jack and the Beanstalk to work on a new project across the school called 'Talk for Writing'. This programme of work uses lots of drama to retell a story using varied vocabulary. We have learnt a version of the story with actions to help us. This will help us when we come to write our own versions of this traditional tale next week!
