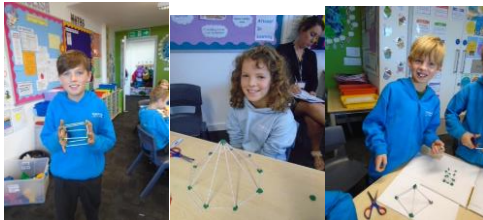
A special mention to our Proud Cloud this week
