Theme of the week: Science week: 06.03.17

The following is a summary of the focused activities we will be carrying out this week *in addition* to child initiated learning.

<u>'Communication and Language'</u>

- Describing what is happening to our plants and discussing as a class.
- Sharing treasure bags.
- © Share "Wow" sheets.

<u>'Literacy'</u>

- © Phonics Letters and Sounds Phase 3.
- © Learn and revist the phonemes: air ure er
- © Practise reading the tricky word "are"
- © Revisit spelling the tricky words "they", "was", "her", "she", "the", "you", "on".
- Use Jolly Phonics songs.
- Practise the alphabet song.
- Writing captions to match pictures.
- Handwriting curly caterpillar letters. Letter formation. Ensure anti clockwise movement. Top to bottom.

Physical Development

- © Outdoor physical activity daily.
- © PE with Mr Barlow Tues am.
- © PE with Mrs Newton Thursday Obstacle courses, practising hopping jumping and landing on one leg.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- © Enjoy a range of activities with our friends.
- Work as part of a group, taking turns and sharing fairly. E.g. in small group phonics games.
- Share VIP books and "Wow" sheets.
- © Circle time on how to be a good friend.

Science and Mathematics

- © Watercress Experiment
- What do plants need to stay alive? How do you know? How can we prove this is true?
- Set up experiment as a class
- Solution Looking at pictures of different plants can we name the parts of a plant? Identify the leaves, flower, stem and roots.
- © Each child to plant their bean seed and add a name label.
- © Exploring magnets
- © Weighing
- © Exploring about light and dark in our dark tent /making shadows.
- Daily splat square counting and shared number sentence writing.
