### 'Communication and Language'

- ☺ Retelling the story of the Three Little Pigs using props.

- ☺ Share treasure bags.
- ☺ Talking about and describing characters from The Three Little Pigs.

### 'Literacy'

- ☺ Daily phonics activities revisiting reading of **have, like, some, come** and spelling of **was** and **you**.
- ☺ What do we know about pigs-fact books.
- ☺ Practise reading all Phase 3 HFW.
- ☺ Practise the alphabet song.
- ☺ ICT phase 4 phonics games.
- ☺ Rewriting the Three Little Pigs story.
- ☺ Writing a letter to the big bad wolf.

### Physical Development

- ☺ Outdoor physical activity daily.
- ☺ Large writing with chalk outside.
- ☺ Dancing to our 1-30 and 30-1 songs.
- ☺ Funky fingers - sorting pom poms.



### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- ☺ Enjoy a range of activities with our friends.
- ☺ Working co-operatively with other children and adults.
- ☺ Share Treasure bags and "Wow" sheets.
- ☺ Circle time



## Mathematics

- ☺ To count to 20 and beyond.
- ☺ Recognise numbers 0-20 and beyond.
- ☺ To revisit measuring short periods of time using a clock.
- ☺ Number songs and rhymes.
- ☺ Recognise and use money: 1p, 2p, 5p, 10p.
- ☺ Playing with money and roleplaying buying and selling.
- ☺ Writing number sentences.
- ☺ Three little pigs story sequencing.
