### 'Communication and Language'

- ☺ Singing familiar nursery and number rhymes. E.g. Five little monkeys, five little speckled frogs.

### Physical Development

- ☺ Outdoor physical activity daily.

### Personal, Social and Emotional Development

- ☺ Spend time exploring and familiarising themselves with the classroom.
