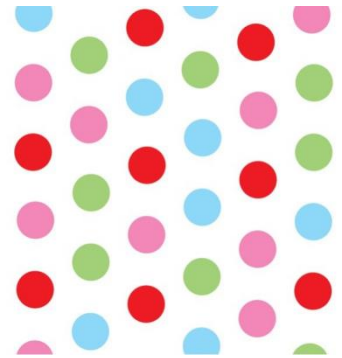
Book bags
