Year 3 Newsletter Friday 12th May

Learning this week

This week in maths we have been learning to divide using practical and mental methods. The children recapped grouping and sharing before moving on to use these skills to solve problems. We also looked at how division is the inverse of multiplication and the children used this knowledge to create division number facts.

In English we have finished the story 'Escape from Pompeii' and concluded our learning from this book by writing a diary entry linked what the main character in the story saw, heard and felt during the eruption of Mount Vesuvius. We also started to look at the features of newspaper reports ready for our work next week.

Pre-learning

In English we will be starting to write our own newspaper report linked to a Volcano erupting. If you could look at headlines with your child and discuss why they are a play on words that would be appreciated.

In Maths we will be continuing to learn about division. We will be using repeated subtraction so could you please practice counting back in steps of 2, 3, 5 and 8.
