Learning this week

This week in English we have been continuing to base our learning around the book 'Escape from Pompeii'. The children worked in groups to write a poem based on the earthquake poem in the book. They then thought about how they would perform this poem to an audience.

In Maths we continued to look at written methods of multiplication with a focus being on the grid method. The children worked very hard to solve a problem linked to using the grid method and they showed a good growth mind set in order to complete it.

In science we planned an investigation linked to 'what plants need to grow.' The children decided on their own conditions to put the seeds in and made predictions based on what they already know. We are looking forward to seeing the results over the week.

Pre-learning

Next week we are learning about division. To help your child it would be beneficial if you could re-cap the key vocabulary with them. Such as: **Share, group, equal, divided by, remainders.**

In English we are going to be looking at newspaper reports so you could look at the features of newspapers with your child.
