Learning this week

In English this week we have been finishing our learning on newspaper reports by writing a report about the removal of the mound. The children learnt to write open ended questions and used the answers to their questions to devise quotes for their articles. Once the children had finished writing their reports, they then went onto edit and improve them even further.

In maths we have been learning about equivalent fractions. The children learnt about fractions that were equivalent to $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{4}$ and $\frac{1}{3}$, $\frac{1}{8}$. Equivalent fractions are often quite a difficult concept to grasp and I was impressed with the 'can do attitude' that most of the class showed toward their learning.
