The following is a summary of the focused activities we will be carrying out this week *in addition* to child initiated learning.

'Communication and Language'

- ☺ Maintains attention, concentrates and sits quietly during appropriate activity.
- ☺ Extends vocabulary, especially by grouping and naming, exploring the meaning and sounds of new words.
- ☺ Uses language to imagine and recreate roles and experiences in play situations.

'Literacy'

- ☺ To identify the initial phoneme in words.
- ☺ To attempt to write phonemes they can hear.
- ☺ Phonics - Letters and Sounds Phase 2
- ☺ Teach new phonemes 'i,n,m,d'
- ☺ Group writing a list.

Physical Development

- ☺ Outdoor physical activity daily.
- ☺ Yoga on Monday pm.
- ☺ Ball skills - PE Thursday pm.
- ☺ Fine motor skills - Making our own treasure maps by cutting, sticking, writing and drawing.

Personal, Social and Emotional Development

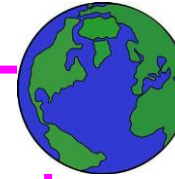
- ☺ Enjoy a range of activities with our friends.
