Learning this week

We've had fun and busy week in school!

In maths this week the children have been learning how to add using 2 and 3 digit numbers mentally. They have used their knowledge of place value to help them to do this. We are also pleased that the children have been trying to use the mathematical language that we have taught them when they are explaining their ideas.

In English the children have started to write their own versions of 'The Stone Age Boy' by changing at least one feature of the story. When writing the children have been asked to think about using exciting adjectives and powerful verbs. We have been SO proud of the writing that they produced so far.

The children have also been working in groups to research the 3 different era's in the Stone Age. They will continue their research next week and then go on to make a presentation to show what they have found out.
